Our patented ultrasonic wheel probe includes nine complementary high-frequency transducers - the most integrated transducers in one unit in the industry - that search for flaws in traverse, longitudinal, and oblique directions.

In addition, we provide a broad range of rail inspection-related services, including rail flaw inspection, U/T certification of replacement rail, crossover testing, data management, and NDT training/certification.

Equipment Services

Nordco Equipment Services rebuilds worn out and obsolete machines from the frame up, incorporating engineering upgrades and technology improvements to deliver like-new equipment with a full factory warranty.

We rebuild a wide selection of our own machines, such as CX Hammers and TRIPP Tie Exchangers. In addition, we also rebuild equipment manufactured by others, including Mark I-IV and Jackson 6700 production tampers.

Mobile Railcar Movers

Nordco's Shuttlewagon mobile railcar movers are the only railcar movers built in America that use rubber tires for traction instead of steel wheels. This technology allows the movers to pull empty and fully loaded railcars more efficiently than comparably sized movers using steel wheels.

Models are sized and outfitted to meet the needs of your operation. They range from a drawbar pulling rating of 15,000 lbs. to more than 60,000 lbs. In addition, there is a remote-controlled model for small moving operations with limited personnel.

We use industry-standard direct-type coupling that readily connect to most American Association of Railroads (AAR) couplers. This means that our mobile railcar movers connect to railcars like a handshake. In addition, unlike railcar movers that must borrow weight by lifting railcars via the railcar's coupler, our movers use their own weight along with the superior tractive power of rubber tires to move railcars.
